



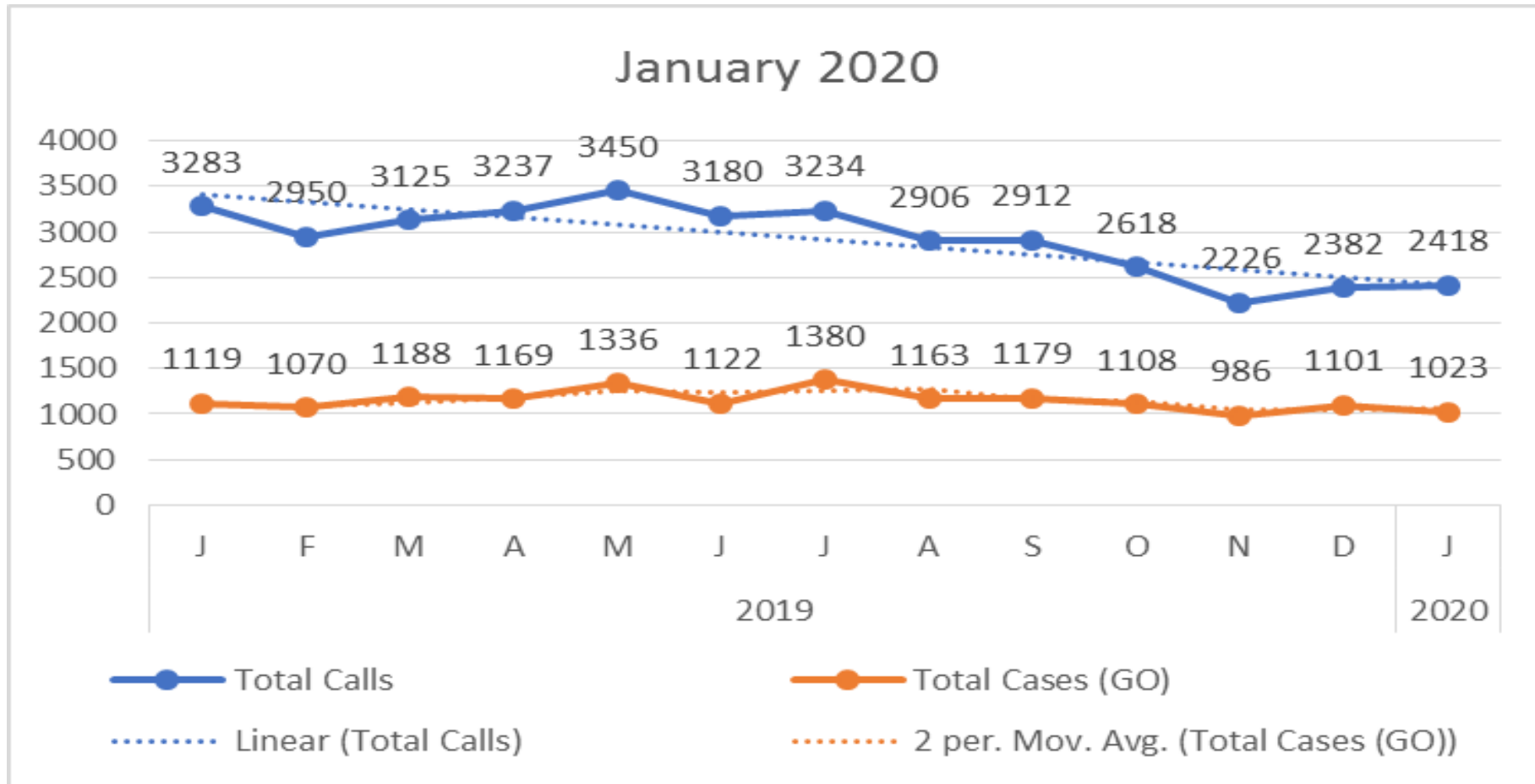

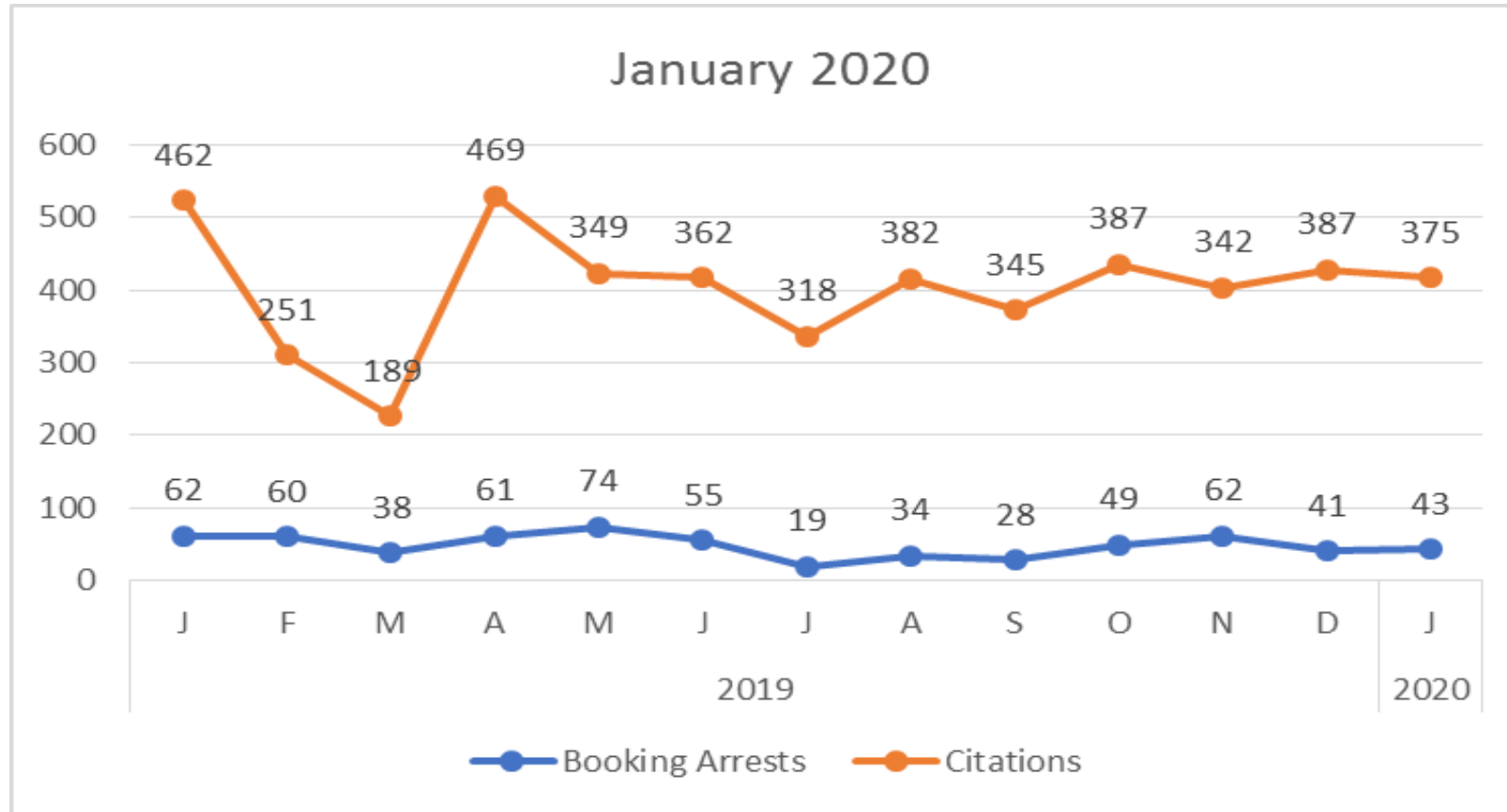

- JAN 9th. Suspect and the victim are related. The Victim and suspect were having a discussion about putting the suspect's wife into a care center. The suspect got upset about this and went into the basement and got his firearm and came upstairs and fired multiple shots at the victim both inside the house and outside on the street hitting him in the arm.
- The victim fled into a neighbor's residence and the suspect went back to his residence and barricaded himself in the basement. The suspect fired multiple shots while barricaded inside the basement.
- Officer arrived and got the victim out of the residence and harms way and to medical who was staged. Officer secured the upstairs of the suspect's residence and held that. SWAT and detectives were called out to the scene. Detectives wrote a warrant and interviewed the victim and witnesses and SWAT breached the door of the residence and took the barricaded suspect into custody. It appeared the suspect had overdosed and was transported to the hospital. Later suspect booked into Jail on multiple felonies. Victim had non life threatening wounds and is currently recovering.

- FEB 3rd 1150 hours
- Several Millcreek and Holladay Officers responded on a Domestic at 2468 E Evergreen Ave. Details indicated a male suspect was armed with a gun. The suspect was located outside and an OIS occurred involving several Officers. No injuries to any Officers. The suspect was pronounced deceased at the scene.
- 6 officers (4 Millcreek, 2 Holladay) are currently on administrative leave per protocol.



Millcreek Street Crimes



- **30 S. Main**
- **Gambling/Money Laundering/Firearms**
- 2 month long investigation
- Some of the identified suspects had gang ties, and known to be armed. Warrants were authored for 8 separate businesses, and for the main suspect's residence
- While entry was being made, two suspects threw handguns from the 5th floor apartment onto Main Street. SWAT members observed this and called down to waiting Detectives who quickly recovered the handguns.
- Simultaneously to this service, Detectives from Millcreek, Midvale, West Valley, Murray, Metro Gangs, and the Attorney General's Office, served search warrants on 8 separate businesses.
- During the search 41 gambling machines, and approximately 24,000 dollars was seized. These illicit funds were earnings for just one day, as the machines are usually cleaned out daily. Additionally, 4 handguns, cocaine, and marijuana were located.
