**A RESOLUTION OF THE MILLCREEK COUNCIL RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING
MILLCREEK STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY DIRECTIVE NO. 3 OF 2020
CONCERNING WAIVER OF THE TEMPORARY SIGN ORDINANCE AND
MILLCREEK STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY DIRECTIVE NO. 4 OF 2020
CONCERNING LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OF COUNTY'S "STAY HOME-STAY
SAFE" ORDER**

WHEREAS, the Millcreek Council ("Council") met in regular session on April 27, 2020, to consider, among other things, a resolution of the Millcreek Council ratifying and confirming Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 3 of 2020 concerning waiver of the temporary sign ordinance and Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 4 of 2020 concerning local law enforcement of county's "Stay Home-Stay Safe" order; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2020, as Resolution No. 20-12, the Council reaffirmed the adopted of Ordinance 20-11 that ratified and confirmed Mayor's Emergency Proclamation No.1 of 2020 declaring a local state of emergency and by the same resolution ratified Emergency Directive No.1 and No. 2; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Council has determined to ratify and confirm Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 3 of 2020 concerning waiver of the temporary sign ordinance and Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 4 of 2020 concerning local law enforcement of county's "Stay Home-Stay Safe" order; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determine that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of Millcreek residents to ratify and confirm Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 3 of 2020 concerning waiver of the temporary sign ordinance and Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 4 of 2020 concerning local law enforcement of county's "Stay Home-Stay Safe" order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council ratifies and confirms Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 3 of 2020 concerning waiver of the temporary sign ordinance and Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive No. 4 of 2020 concerning local law enforcement of county's "Stay Home-Stay Safe" order and that such Declarations are in full force and effect until such Declarations are terminated by subsequent resolution of the Council.

FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that all actions heretofore or hereafter reasonably taken by any of the Millcreek's officers or employees in connection with such Declarations are hereby ratified and approved.

This Resolution assigned No. 20-15, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
