



**PROCLAMATION
JUNE 2021 AS PRIDE MONTH IN MILLCREEK**

WHEREAS, Millcreek is a diverse community where residents and businesses are empowered to respectfully engage and interact with each other in governance and volunteerism to maintain a fiscally responsible, environmentally sustainable City that provides a “welcome home” feeling to everyone-past present and future; and

WHEREAS, our diversity includes our LGBTQ+ community; and

WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court ruled in June 2015 that same-sex couples can marry nationwide, establishing a new civil right in our country and breaking down vestiges of discrimination and opprobrium against friends and loved ones based upon their orientation or their identity; and

WHEREAS, our City’s Policies recognize that it is wrong and improper to discriminate on the basis of any person’s orientation or identity; and

WHEREAS, all members of the Millcreek community, including those who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer or questioning, intersex and asexual have the right to feel safe, not be discriminated against, and to live without the threat of harassment; and

WHEREAS, the LGBTQ+ community has made great strides; however, work remains in order to achieve full equality, inclusion, and acceptance.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Jeff Silvestrini, Mayor of Millcreek, Utah, do hereby declare the month of **June 2021 as LGBTQ+ Pride Month**.
