Chair Silvestrini called the meeting to order.

1. Fiscal Year 2022-23 Community Reinvestment Agency Tentative Budget

Presentation; Laurie Johnson, HR-Finance Director

Laurie Johnson reviewed the revenue budget. The total revenues from property tax and loan proceeds for Millcreek Center CRA was \$721,800 and property tax revenue for West Millcreek CRA was \$1,200,250. The Millcreek Center CRA expense budget showed the debt interest. In FY23 and FY24, the portion of bond payment is interest only. In FY25, the principal gets added to the interest expense, starting at \$140,000 then gradually increasing. The bond is due to be paid by June 2040. She said the West Millcreek CRA expense budget reflected the loan to the Millcreek Center CRA and tax increment commitments. The total loan to the Millcreek Center CRA through FY22 was \$1,950,466.

Mike Winder said the loan amount on Millcreek Center had gone down. He said once the projects under construction were completed in the next couple of years, the increment would increase.

Tentatively Adopting the Tentative Budget for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2022, and Ending June 30, 2023

Board Member Jackson moved to adopt Resolution 22-07, acknowledging receipt of the Community Reinvestment Agency tentative budget, and tentatively adopting the tentative budget. Board Member Catten seconded. The Recorder called for the vote. All Board Members present voted yes. The motion passed unanimously.
