Millcreek State of Local Emergency Directive  
No. 6 of 2020

November 9, 2020

WHEREAS on March 12, 2020, the Millcreek Mayor issued Emergency Proclamation No. 1 of 2020; and

WHEREAS on November 8, 2020, Utah Governor Gary R. Herbert issued Executive Order 2020-72 Declaring a state of emergency due to rising COVID 19 case counts creating a shortage of hospital beds; and

WHEREAS also on November 8, 2020, Governor Herbert issued Executive Order 2020-73 enacting a statewide mask mandate, imposing mandatory restrictions on businesses and restricting certain social activities;

THEREFORE: For the period from November 9, 2020 to and including November 25, 2020, Millcreek City Hall shall be open by appointment only, except for public meetings and public hearings, and in those cases masks are required to be worn by all at all times and social distancing and hygiene requirements shall be enforced. The city's public wifi shall be restricted to outdoor use only. City staff are encouraged to work remotely to the extent possible consistent with direction from each department director. If compliance with this order proves difficult, staff are authorized to lock the doors to City Hall during business hours provided signs explaining the "by appointment|" requirement are visible to those visiting.
